

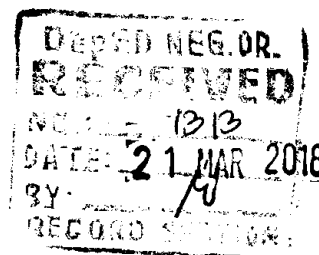

**To: All Directors of Music, Teachers for the Regional Special Program for the Arts (SPA) Performing/Visual Arts Teachers and Senior High School Arts and Design Track Teachers:**

In the interest of growth and development of Arts Teachers primarily from schools with Special Program for the Arts (SPA) and Arts and Design Track and other art enthusiasts, the Silliman University College of Performing and Visual Art and the University Culture and Arts Council in partnership with the Cultural Center of the Philippines, will hold the 2018 CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES SUMMER ARTS ACADEMY National Workshop for Arts and Design Track from April 23-27, 2016 at the Luce Auditorium, Silliman Hall, Silliman University Dumaguete City.

The CCP has been implementing the training for the Department of Education's Special Program in the Arts (SPA) Pilot schools. Recently, the CCP has been working closely with the DepEd for the K-12 Arts and Design Track curriculum, course packs and teacher training. The SSE workshop is especially designed to teachers with the offering of artistic experiences that would upgrade their knowledge and skills of their respective art forms. The workshop modules shall incorporate discussion/topics on research, pedagogical practices, and the current context of teaching and learning as we move into the K to 12 curriculum. It prepares teachers to develop artistic processes that would help them seek out and solve pedagogical issues by using critical thinking and innovate approaches for the K to 12 curriculum and the challenges that its forthcoming implementation presents. It also provides supplementary art and cultural instructional materials, and other assistance for the arts education program of the schools, including the indigenization of the curriculum.



**2018 CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES SUMMER ARTS ACADEMY**

1. The Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), through its Arts Education Department, will conduct a series of workshops under the **2018 CCP Summer Arts Academy** for teachers of Senior High School (SHS) Arts and Design Track, and the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) from April 23 to 27, 2018 at the Silliman University, Dumaguete City and from April 30 to May 4, 2018 at the Cultural Center of the Philippines, CCP Complex, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City and the University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City.

2. The 2018 CCP Summer Arts Academy is especially designed to provide teachers (non-beginners) with professional and specialized training on their respective art forms, to build their capacities and advance their creative development by focusing on production and performance techniques/processes, arts knowledge and skills, and pedagogical approaches. Only 25 teachers will be accepted per module.

3. Preference will be given to teacher-applicants who are actively engaged in creative and artistic/management productions/activities or those who are actively engaged in mentoring/coaching students in the arts for recent competitions such as National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA), National Festival of Talents (NFOT) and other national and international competitions/exhibitions in the different fields of art.

4. The 2018 CCP Arts Academy shall consist of workshops and training modules to be facilitated by teachers-artists and practitioners from the CCP resident companies and partners.

5. The workshop modules include the following:

	<b>Ballet/Contemporary Technique</b> by Ballet Philippines (BP)	This focuses on the processes and tools in ballet and contemporary dance technique.
	<b>Musical Arranging for Rondalla</b> by Nelson Espejo	This aims to enable the teachers to learn the fundamentals of musical arranging for rondalla.
	<b>Advanced Acting</b> by <i>Tanghalang Pilipino</i>	This aims to arm teachers with advanced acting methods and techniques.
	<b>Technical Theater</b> by Barbara Tantiongco, ACC Grantee	This is a practical technical theater technique on lighting, set sound, and house management.
	<b>Printmaking Techniques</b> by Association of <i>Pinoy</i> Printmakers	This aims to train teachers on the wonders and different applications of printmaking.
	<b>Cinematography</b> by Neil Daza	This aims to train teachers on the art of writing scripts.
	<b>Scriptwriting</b> by Glenn Mas ACC Grantee	This aims to train teachers on the art of writing scripts.
April 30-May 4, 2018	<b>Design for Folk Dance Performance</b> by Ramon Obusan Folkloric Group	A specialized workshop in costume, accessories design and performance.
Cultural Center of the Philippines	<b>Production Design</b> To be announced (TBA)	Teachers will be immersed or by various set and production design techniques for performing arts.
April 30-May 4, 2018  UP Theater Complex, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City	<b>Directing Theater</b> by Josefina Estrella, ACC Grantee	This is a specialized course in directing for theater.
	<b>Arts Education Pedagogy</b> TBA	This is a workshop on the pedagogies of teaching the arts.


