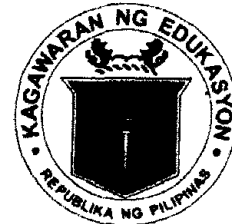

6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is directed.

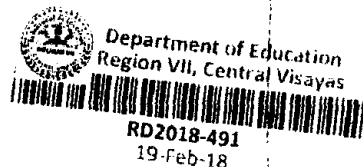


