

PROGRAM FLOW:

Part 1: General Discussion (40 minutes)

There will be a discussion on the salient points of online sexual abuse and exploitation of children based on the results of the two (2) studies by the investigators of the **Philippine Kids Online Study: Dr. Rhod Nuncio** (principal investigator) and **Dr. Myla Arcinas** (co-investigator); and the **National Study on OSAEC care of Dr. Maria Caridad Tarroja** (principal investigator).

The 20-minute presentation on the **Philippine Kids Online Study** will focus on highlighting the findings on the access of the Filipino children to the internet, activities to which children are engaged online, digital skills, risks, upsetting circumstances for children, and the recommendations of the study for the target audience composed of parents and children.

Meanwhile, the 20-minute presentation on the **National Study on OSAEC** will focus on highlighting the definition of OSAEC vis-à-vis its technological evolution, profiles of the offenders, perpetrators, child-victims, and their families, motivations, recruitment, grooming, reintegration, and the impact of OSAEC. Likewise, the recommendations of the studies for the families and communities shall also be presented.

Part 2: Group Discussions (45 minutes)

To delve deeper into some of the key points in the studies, the participants will be asked to join any of the three (3) break-out rooms that will hold specific discussions. These are as follows:

- **OSAEC Prevention** – Dr. Myla Arcinas
- **Online Safety** – Dr. Rhod Nuncio
- **Helping Victims** – Dr. Maria Caridad Tarroja

A celebrity-influencer will also join the investigators in facilitating the conversation with the audience. The celebrity-influencer will ask curated questions to be prepared beforehand and will cite tips and recommendations on how the audience who will join the break-out sessions can become actual advocates and 'influencers' within their own communities on the issue OSAEC.



Part 3: Plenary Discussion (20 minutes)

During the plenary discussion, the celebrity-influencers will synthesize what has been discussed in the break-out rooms and will share some tips on how the attendees can creatively present their learnings to their respective communities and organizations.
