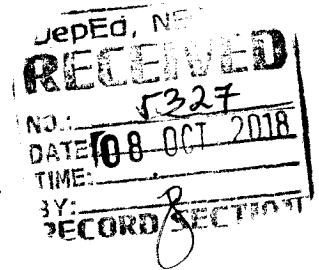

Let us all meet in this conference to make a difference! Thank you very much!

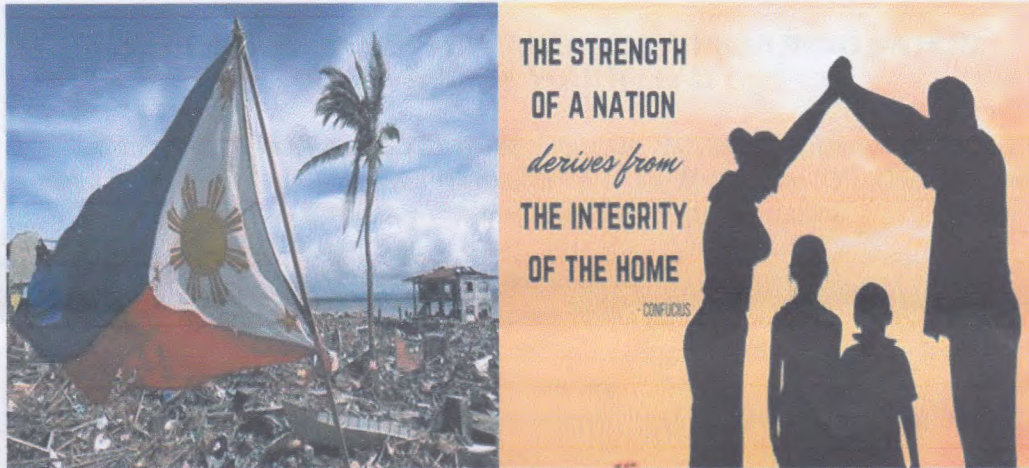

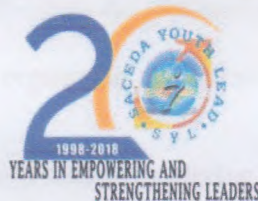
