I know it has been a rough yet a very productive year for both of our offices, but I am so proud to say that we have handled it strongly. We have reached a mass amount of adolescents and we're able to create more awareness because of your full support and cooperation. This year, we hope to continue that partnership with you.

If you could remember last year, we've launched the program "Heart To HEAR Talk"; it was a brainchild program of POPCOM VII, and it was replicated all-over the country. "**Heart to H.E.A.R.T. Talk**" is a program created to talk about the current HEART issues of our adolescents, namely:

- H – HIV/AIDS/STI
- E – Early Sexual Encounters
- A – Adolescent Sexuality
- R – Reproductive Health and
- T – Teenage Pregnancy Prevention

Because of the memorandum you've released last year, we've reached around 20,000 students and around 121 Heart to Heart Talk Sessions in various schools in the region. This success won't be made possible without your commitment and support to our Adolescent Health and Development Program and we thank you for that.

This year, we plan to continue the program and instead of doing it just on February, it will now be implemented all-year round to reach out to even more adolescents and youth. This activity intends to educate High School students the importance of delaying sexual debut and fight shy early sexual encounters (premarital sex) to avoid getting pregnant at a young age and avoid acquiring HIV and other sexually transmitted infections (STI). It will just be a 2 hour session composed of film showing and short discussions, still in lined with our mantra "*learning while having fun*".

In line with this, we would once again ask for your support. The memorandum that you've created last has really played a vital role in the attainment of the campaign.

The assistance that we will only needing from the participating/interested school/s is a classroom, preferably an audio visual room or computer lab, and the student participants.
