a maximum of 30 seconds (0.5 minutes) for opening credits

a maximum of 60 seconds (I minute) for closing credits

total film duration must not exceed 6:30 minutes (390 seconds) mitted entries must not include any indication or reference to the creators, the creators' school, region, other identifying marks. Only the film's title may be used to identify the project. Teams are allowed to produce a version with complete titles and credits for their personal consumption but this copy should not be submitted to the competition.

Entries should be saved in a flash drive encoded in MP4, WMV, AVI or MOV format submitted on the event date before the specified cut-off or deadline.

Medium of communication should be in Filipino and/or English. However, subtitles may be used ONLY for films in local languages.

Videos should be an original work of the student-participants and shall not infringe on any copyrights or any rights of any third parties.

Images shown and presented in the film must have been taken during the 2018 National Festival of Talents. If the film requires pre-existing, stock, or news footage, these may be used to a maximum of 20% of the film and must

be royalty-free, in the public domain, or under a Creative Commons license for attribution (BY) and non-commerciai use (NC)

be obtained from a recognized news or information agency (e.g. CNN, GMA News, etc.)





- properly cite artists and works in the closing credits (Artist, Title, website/ source) Films are encouraged to use music or sound elements taken or produced during the 2018 National Festival of Talents. Films are also allowed to use non-original music and sounds provided that:
 - the works are available for use royalty-free, in the public domain, or under a Creative Commons license for attribution (BY) and non-commercial use (NC)
 - these are obtained from recognized royalty-free or Creative Commons sources (e.g. SoundCloud, Jamendo, WikiMedia)
 - the artists and works are properly cited in the closing credits (Artist, Title, website/source)
- Teams may use to choose any style (e.g. observational, participative, journalistic, or reflexive) and utilize various tools to deliver content (e.g. narration, on-camera, interviews, music, dramatization/s, etc.) but it must be noted that the emphasis of the competition is on visual storytelling rather than narrated or textual stories.
- Teams will be briefed on the rules and parameters of the competition. Each team will be given access to the same general film location and a space for post-production.
- Each judge will prepare theme for the draw lots to be used in the actual competition during the orientation.
- The official competition time will begin and end at times designated by the NTWG; all teams location designated by the NTWG. Films must be submitted to the competition marshals as the and time.

 - Coaches are responsible for managing the team, keeping competitors focus maintaining team dynamics, and ensuring completion and adherence to the a)

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GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA on DIVISION-INITIATED ACTIVITIES: FOLKSAYAW & HIMIG HI-SKUL COMPETITIONS

A. FOLKSAYAW

Elementary— Level- Rural Folk Dance Secondary--- Western-Influenced Dance

GUIDELINES:

- The Folkdance Competition is open to all Public Elementary and Secondary Schools including the Senior High School enrolled this school –year 2018-2019. Rural Folk Dance will be for the elementary level and Western-Influenced dance will be for the Junior or/ and Senior High School
- 2. There is no age limit as long as the student is enrolled in the specified grade/ year levels.
- 3. There must only be one entry per municipality within the Negros Oriental Division.
- 4. Each entry shall be composed of 6-10 pairs or 12-20 performers only.
- 5. Folkdance shall be chosen from any of the published Philippine Folk Dances
- 6. Total performing time must not exceed 5 minutes including the entrance and the exit.

 Performances which will exceed the allotted time will be deducted with 2 points per excess minute or a fraction thereof.
- 7. Contestants must provide their own labelled CDs to be submitted on or before Nov. 3, 2016. (Attn: Culture and Arts Coordinator)
- 8. Costume must be appropriate to the dance chosen. Props may be used but must be minimal and readily transportable on and off stage.
- 9. All entry forms must be handed in to the Division Office through **Mrs. Jenith Corpis Cabajon**, *Div. Coordinator in Culture & Arts* November 3, 2018.
- 10. The decision of the judges is final.
- 11. The performances will be judged according to the following criteria:

Performance (Execution, Rhythm and Grace)		35%
Appropriateness of Costume		15%
Interpretation / Choreography		30%
Mastery and Discipline		20%

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B. HIMIG HI-SKUL (Secondary Only)

GUIDELINES & CRITERIA:

- 1. Each choral group must be composed of at least 20 members or at most 25 secondary students from the Junior or/and Senior High School including the conductor and accompanist. Members must be a bonafide student and currently enrolled this school-year.
- 2. Each competing choir will sing two songs:
 - a) Folk Song (Obligatory piece)
 - b) The supporting piece is a free choice in any version and in 3 to 4 minutes performance time which can be performed with accompaniment or in acapella. Medley is not allowed.
- 3. Each choir is encouraged to wear an appropriate and inexpensive costume/ attire to give visual impact on the performance.
- 4. In case there's no teacher who can train or interpret the musical score, the group can hire choir trainer and pianist from the LGU or DepEd. Guitar can be used if there's no available pianist. Absolutely, no minus-one or any recorded accompaniment is allowed. The conductor must be a teacher.
- 5. Accompaniment is limited to 3 instruments plano, guitar, double bass.
- 6. The two songs can be performed in any order without choreography, no using of props and lighting effects.
- 7. Participating choir must attend the final and technical rehearsal which shall be scheduled by the organizing committee.
- 8. Violation to any of the rules and guidelines is subject for disqualification.
- 9. The decision of the panel of judges is deemed final and not appealable.
- 10. All entry forms must be handed in to the Division Office through Mrs. Jenith Corpis Cabajon, Div. Coordinator in Culture & Arts on November 3, 2018
