In compliance with the provisions in DepEd Order No. 35, s. 2016 entitled "The Learning Action Cell as a K to 12 Basic Education Program School-Based Continuing Professional Development Strategy for the Improvement of Teaching and Learning" Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs) are requested to include Care and Use of Mathematics Learning Support Materials as one of the priority topics for the month of November.
