5. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

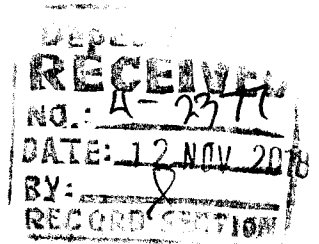

A registration fee of **Five Pesos (P500.00)** for each participant to defray expenses for materials, souvenir items, ids, certificates and other administrative cost.


**3. Official list of participants should be submitted at the BSP Headquarters on or before November 23, 2018 to prepare the souvenirs and materials.**


