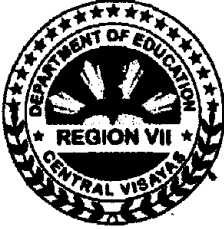
PILOT TESTING OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED MULTI-FACTORED ASSESSMENT TOOLS (MFAT)

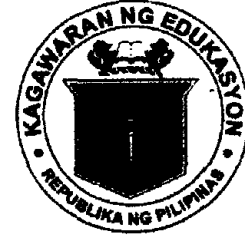

3. Results of the pilot testing activity and feedback will be submitted in the division on March 3, 2018 by the concerned selected teachers.
4. Teacher-assessors and the focal person have to prepare and reproduce the MFAT materials on February 23, 24 and 25, 2018 and will conduct the assessment on Monday, Feb 26, 2018.
5. Personnel listed will be entitled to a Compensatory Time and service credits to the teachers rendering services during Saturdays and Sundays.

PILOT TESTING OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED MULTI-FACTORED ASSESSMENT TOOLS



To: ALL SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS

1. Multi-Factored Assessment Tool (MFAT) is a screening tool intended to gather information on learner's strengths, needs, learning styles, and other educational concerns. It shall be conducted in all schools a month after the beginning of each school year. This is a one-time assessment administered to Grade I learners enrolled in the regular schools who may exhibit developmental advancement or delays or with manifestations of learning disability.
2. This office through the Curriculum Learning and Management Divisions came up with a contextualized version of the tool last January 17-19, 2018. Such needs to be pilot tested in order to get its strengths and limitations and eventually generate an improved and final copy to be used in the field.
3. All the division SPED Supervisors/ focal persons are directed to conduct pilot testing of the said tool using the suggested materials on February 19- March 2, 2018. They shall choose 2 learners that shows developmental delays in any school in their respective divisions. For those divisions who have trained teacher-assessors, Division SPED focal persons may opt to let them do the pilot testing with their guidance.
4. Result of the pilot testing activity and feedback from the field shall be consolidated per division using the attached template. Consolidated copy shall be submitted to this office on or before March 9, 2018.
