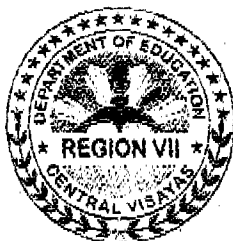

**TRANSITIONAL EFFECT OF CHANGE IN AGE CUT- OFF FOR KINDERGARTEN
ENROLLED IN THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR**

To: Schools Division/City Superintendents
Assistant Schools Division/City Superintendents
Officers-in-Charge of Regular and Interim Schools Division
CID/SGOD Chiefs

1. As stated in DepEd Central Office Memorandum, OM-SEC-2017-053 dated December 27, 2017 from Hon. Leonor M. Briones, Secretary, Department of Education, **kindergarten pupils**, who are enrolled in the current school year and whose age are below the cut-off age, are allowed to enroll and be promoted to Grade 1 in the succeeding year (SY 2018 - 2019), **provided that they are at that point academically ready to meet the demands of Grade 1. This means that they should have passed the summative assessment for the Kindergarten level.**

2. However, please take note of DepEd Order No. 3, s. 2018, "Basic Education Enrollment Policy for School Year 2018-2019", that both public and private schools should strictly adhere beginning the ensuing year.

"Entry age for Kindergarten learners in both public and private schools must be five (5) years old by August 31st of the school year they will enroll in where documentary requirement is only the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Birth Certificate".

3. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
