- 3. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 66, s. 2018, the categories for the Search for Brigada Eskwela Best Implementing Schools are as follows:

- 8. The congressional district selection must be able to choose Top 3 winners each in the elementary and secondary levels which will all compete as finalists for the Division Level. Official Entries must be submitted to the Division Office on July 5, 2018.
- 9. Finalists from the congressional district must see to it that their documents are completely arranged and orderly featuring pictures of each prioritized activity in the Brigada Eskwela (BE) as reflected in BE Form 1. Pictures must have captions taken before, during, and after the BE. Attendance Sheets with diverse participation must be properly filed and the whole document in an "ALBUM" should appear as a **COMPLETE PACKAGE** of the school observing the criteria stipulated in DepEd Memo No. 66, s. 2018. Every activity must be supported with Means of Verification (MoV) to merit points. The preparation of the Album is equivalent to the making of a school propaganda and advertisement of the school.
- 10. The Criteria for the Selection is as follows:

Scope of Work	- 35%
Diverse Volunteer Participation	- 25%
Generated Resources	-15%
Alignment to Brigada Eskwela Theme	-10%
Creativity and Innovation	-10%
Increment of Resources and Volunteers	- 5%
