General Guidelines for the Conduct of the Division NDPR Culmination on July 28, 2018

- 1. Each SPED Center/ Class in the district shall conduct their own competitions to select the best contestants in all categories.
- 2. Participants to this competition are currently enrolled in a SPED center or class both in elementary and secondary.
- 3. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
- 4. The number of contestants in the registration form shall be his/her official number during the contest.
- 5. The coaches are reminded to secure duly signed permits from parents regarding their children's participation to the said contest.
- 6. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly. Winners per category will be identified per criteria by the Board of Judges.
- 7. All winners will receive medals- 1st gold, 2nd silver, 3rd bronze.
- 8. The panel of Judges shall be composed of a Chairman and 2 members. The decision of the board of judges is final.
