Greetings!

Recent Philippine studies show that 1 in 5 Filipino adults are suffering from mental disorders. This plus the 10 to 15% of children aged 5 to 15 believed affected by mental health problems as well. According to a 2014 report of the World Health Organization, there were 2,558 cases of suicide due to mental health problems in the Philippines in the year 2012 alone. These statistics tell the sad story about the mental health situation in the Philippines.

As a public concern, mental illness hits the most vulnerable sectors of society- the young and the poor. And while it is long overdue, schools should put importance in this aspect of Philippine healthcare. Conversations should start within families and most importantly the schools, where help is within reach. The shadow of stigma and discrimination should begin in the basic units of society.

Dear Dr. Bongalion:

Greetings!

Suicide is the third leading cause of death for 15- to 24 years old and through the passing of years, they get younger and younger. Suicide does not just happen. Studies show that at least 90% of teens who kill themselves have some type of mental health problem, such as depression, anxiety, drug or alcohol abuse or a behavior problem (Teen Suicide Statistics). They may also have problems at school or with friends or family, or a combination of all these things. Some teens may have been victims of sexual or physical abuse. Others may be struggling with issues related to sexual identity. Usually they have had problems for some time.

Teachers, guidance counselors and co-students play a BIG role in the decline in teen suicide by its early detection, evaluation and effective treatment by professionals.


