Madam:

Greetings!

The 2011 survey on Children showed that there are 2.1 million child laborers. The said data of the Philippine Statistics Authority (formely National Statistic Office) was confirmed in a survey conducted by the Unites States Department of Labor (US DOL) wherein majority of these child laborers are in the agricultural sector and Negros Oriental as one of the top three (3) sugar producing province of the country.

Thus, under the Duterte Administration's "2017 - 2022 Philippine Development Plan", 30% or 630,000 of these children surveyed in 2011 are targeted to be withdrawn from Child Labor and 1 million by 2025, thus, the #1M Batang Malaya campaign.

Relative to this target, which is a commitment by President Rodrigo Duterte to the Filipino people and to the international community, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), as Secretariat to the National Child Labor Committee (NCLC), is facilitating the conduct of Child Labor Profiling activities nationwide. The DOLE RO7-Negros Oriental Field Office is lobbying and coordinating with the different Local Government Units (LGU) of the Province thru the Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) to include in their annual budget the profiling of children starting 2019.

In the meantime that more than a year is already behind in accomplishing this commitment under the Philippine Development Plan, we are requesting the following major stakeholders to facilitate the conduct of child labor profiling for this year only to generate data for 2018.

- > The Pantawid Pampamilya Pilipino Program (4Ps) of the Department of Social Welfare and **Development** – to profile suspected child laborers of their family-beneficiaries;
- The Department of Education to profile suspected child laborer who are in school;
- The Visayan Forum (the uits Provincial Coordinator, Ms. Marlene Pepino) to assist and help facilitate the conduct of profiling by DepEd as well as profiling also of their beneficiary-barangays & families;
- > Job Order under the PESO of Negros Oriental to profile other sector not covered by the 4Ps and DepEd;

Results of the profiling will be submitted to the PESO of Zamboanguita, Mr. Joel Elnar, for encoding by the Government Intern deployed by DOLE for consolidation and submission to the Bureau of Workers with Special Concerns and National Economic and Development Authority.
