CONTEXTUALIZED LOCAL POLICY ON DISSEMINATION AND UTILIZATION OF COMPLETED RESEARCH STUDIES GRANTED OF BASIC EDUCATION RESEARCH FUND (BERF)

TO: REGIONAL RESEARCH COMMITTEE (RRC) CHAIR CHIEFS OF THE FUNCTIONAL DIVISIONS ALL SCHOOLS' DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS SCHOOLS' DIVISION RESEARCH COMMITTEE (SDRC) CHAIR ALL CONCERNED

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 16 s. 2017 better known as "Research Management Guidelines" (RMG) and in support of the Department's Policy Development process, Research Agenda, and Policy and Program Development and Implementation, the Department of Education (DepEd) continues to promote and strengthen the culture of research in basic education.
- 2. Dissemination and utilization of results are essential in the realization of learning comes, and improve teaching-learning and governance in Schools, Districts, and Schools' Division Office's. Research managers, research coordinators in collaboration with the researchers, will take measures to ensure the dissemination and utilization of research results in various setting across governance levels.
- 3. In this initiative, researchers shall disseminate and discuss their research results and recommendations in the area / office / governance level where the study was conducted, preferably attended by the respondents. Research managers and research coordinators shall provide a venue to actively disseminate results from completed research studies, and encourage everyone to ANALYZE, CONSIDER, and INTEGRATE these results in their practices.
- 4. The Division may organize research / congress conferences, research forums, and policy forums to gather education researchers to share their research findings, gather new inputs and research ideas, and discuss policy options based on research results. Further, research managers and research coordinators may also publish research journals and bulletins for wider dissemination, and a potential archival mechanism for completed research.
- 5. In addition, the region and division may utilize completed researches to improve learning outcomes and governance processes in their respective areas. The evidence should be heavily used in the following:
 - development of policies, frameworks programs, and projects:
 - strategic, operational and mid-term plans;
 - training programs;
 - instructional materials, to mention a few governance strategies.
- With full support of TEACHERS and RESEARCHERS from DISTRICTS and DIVISIONS' DEFICES. and those who are profoundly involved in research, shall disseminate and utilize their research through existing mechanisms such as, but not limited to, the following venues:
 - Learning Action Cells (LACs). The LAC sessions may be maximized by sharing the results of angoing and/or completed research. These may serve as input for teachers in their respective teaching-learning strategies.
 - In-Service Trainings (INSETs). The training design may include discussions on research results and how these can be utilized.
 - School Governing Councils (SGCs). Research results and proposed actions can be presented during school planning and monitoring activities.
 - Enhanced School Improvement Plan / Annual Implementation Plan (AIPs) Research results may be incorporated in the SIP. School planning activities may bring forth possible research topics. These may also be plotted as research initiatives in the SIPs and AIPs.
 - School Report Card (SRCs). Interventions made as result of action results may be included in the SRCs
