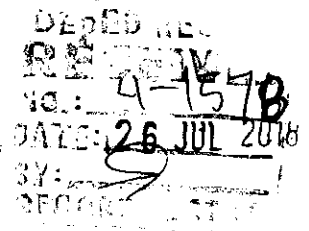
1. Attached herewith is the information letter from the BSP Negros Oriental which is self explanatory.



Please wear white t-shirts, jeans and Rover Scouts Neckerchief.


