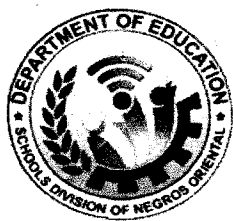

4. All schools shall thoroughly follow the guidelines below; non-compliance is tantamount to non-acceptance of said reports.
 - School DRRM Coordinators shall submit the reports only to respective District Offices not later than three (3) work days after the activity.
 - District DRRM Coordinators/Alternates shall consolidate NSED reports from the school and shall submit only to Division Office not later than nine (9) work days after the activity through the online form at <http://bit.ly/NSEDnegor>

Problems Encountered

The following problems were encountered during the activity:

- Weather was not good;
- Insufficient DRRM tools and equipment;
- Some of the School might had performed the NSED but were not able to submit report as a requirement.

- Lack of personnel from BFP
- Pupils lack of supervision by their adviser/teacher
- Some pupils/students were not executing the proper procedure, duck-cover-hold.

General Recommendations

Based on the evaluation submitted from our district offices, here are the following recommendations:

- Evaluators must be knowledgeable enough about Earthquake Drill.
- PTA officials and Barangay officials should have participated the conduct of the Earthquake Drill.
- If possible 1 expert evaluator in every school.
- NSED should be conducted after flag ceremony.
- The school administrators must encourage/oblige their personnel, students and Stakeholders to participate the activity
- There should be a first aid training for the DRRM school coordinators.
- DepEd shall allocate sufficient budget in purchasing medical kit
- The school personnel, pupils, and parents must be given concrete capacity building on how to properly act before, during and after the disaster.
- Proper orientation/seminar of all school school DRRM Coordinators.





Rule 6, Section 7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the RA 10121 states that "Public awareness shall also be undertaken through the conduct of drills by the LDRRMO on a regular basis". Likewise, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (NDRRMP) states that one of the activities to achieve Outcome 10: "Developed and implemented comprehensive national and local preparedness and response policies, plans and systems" is to develop/ enhance and simulate scenario-based preparedness and response plans. Furthermore, one of the policy framework stated in the National Disaster Preparedness Plan as embedded in the fourth priority area of the Sendai Framework for Action 2015 – 2030 includes the target: "to promote regular disaster preparedness, response and recovery exercises".

In view hereof, the schedule for the CY 2018 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) is hereby disseminated:

1 st Quarter	15 February 2018
2 nd Quarter	10 May 2018
3 rd Quarter	16 August 2018
4 th Quarter	15 November 2018

The first quarter NSED ceremonial venue will be in **Quezon City** and will commence at **1400H**. Actual location and other details are to be determined based on the results of the coordination meetings of the OCD with relevant stakeholders.

The objectives are as follows:


1. To test the efficiency and usefulness of the preparedness, response and recovery plans, systems and policies developed in their respective localities/ offices/ schools;
2. To evaluate the effectiveness of contingency plan;
3. To test the coordination and communication mechanism during response operation.
4. To understand the command and control mechanism in emergency and disaster operation at the DRRMCs.

All NDRRMC member agencies, Metro Manila RDRRMC member agencies, and Regional Chairpersons of all RDRRMCs are enjoined to spearhead the conduct of earthquake drill in their areas of jurisdiction.

Proper documentation and the conduct of the Post Activity Evaluation is encouraged. Result of the analysis and documentation should be submitted to the OCD Capacity Building and Training Service through electronic mail at cbts@ocd.gov.ph not later than 20 days after the activity for consolidation and submission to the Chairperson, NDRRMC.
