Pursuant to the provisions of DepED Order No. 16 s. 2017 better known as the "Research Management Guidelines" and in support of the Department's Policy Development Process, Research Agenda and Policy and Program Development and Implementation, the Department of Education (DepED) continues to promote and strengthen the culture of research in basic education.
- 2. This Office, through the Policy, Planning and Research Division (PPRD) informs the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and Schools Division Research Committees (SDRCs) the herein list of approved research titles funded under the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) 2018 and are hereby enjoined to regularly monitor the progress of the conduct of the researches and the proper utilization of the said fund. The first tranche of the grant was already released last July, 2018. The six-month researches will end by November, 2018 while the one-year researches will end by May 2019 or earlier.
- 3. Submission of liquidation for the first tranche (6-month researches) is already due this August, 2018 while that of the 1-year researches will be on September, 2018. DepED Order No.16 states that the research starts from the date of the Memorandum Of Agreement (MOA) signing.
