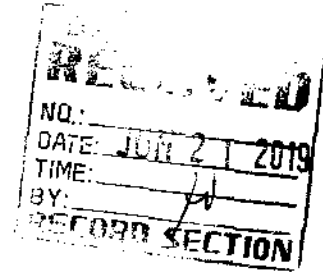

SAND SCULPTURE ESQUISSE 2019
THEME: "Incredibly 70"

GUIDELINES:

- 1. Teams have 2 hours to make a sand sculpture (10AM-12:00PM)**
- 2. There will be one (1) entry for each TEAM, with members having a minimum of four (4) and a maximum of five (5).**
- 3. One (1) member should participate in one (1) team only.**
- 4. Use only SAND and WATER for the finished sand sculpture.**
- 5. No props or reinforcements are allowed in the sculpture – no sticks, fiber/rope, stone, etc.**
- 6. If a SAND CASTLE is built – it warrants immediate disqualification (and a failing grade for FU Architecture students only). Note that creations should be a Sand Sculpture. Other building forms may be used but must have no portion of it that has a castle-like form.**
- 7. FU Architecture students Only - Grades received from the judges will be credited to the student's studio grade.**
- 8. Judging will commence right after the allotted time**
- 9. Judging Criteria:**
 - a. Aesthetics - Artistic Impression 30%**
 - b. Difficulty - Attention to Detail 30%**
 - c. Creativity - Relevance to the THEME 40%**
- 10. All groups should provide their own tools – shovels, buckets, hand tools, spray, etc.**
- 11. Hand tools and forms of any sort may be used in the construction process but in no way may support the final sculpture.**
- 12. NO GLASS, RUSTY CANS, METAL CONSTRUCTION SHEETS, and POWER TOOLS ARE ALLOWED**
- 13. Participants should not leave the activity area until judging is done.**
- 14. Participants should bring appropriate sun protection (hats, sunglasses, etc.) and drinking water.**
