Yuletide greetings from the NATCCO Network!

Through your support, the social and financial advocacy of the Aflatoun Program is now making positive changes in the lives of children in Siaton, Negros Oriental! We have successfully launched the Program in ten (10) schools in the municipality in partnership with our local implementer Bonbonon Farmers Multi-Purpose Cooperative (BOFARMPUCO). Since November, the Program has welcomed **556 students from 10 schools** who are now saving up to a total of **P 52,707.85** for their future! Parents also warmly welcomed Aflatoun in the schools and are actively involved in the implementation; they opened savings accounts for their children to help teach them how to save on their own.

One of the components of Financial Education in the K-12 Program is Entrepreneurship. NATCCO and CFLI, together with our partner cooperative BOFARMPUCO, strongly believe that we can enhance the entrepreneurial mindset of children through education, exposure, and meaningful participation in entrepreneurial activities. This is also one of the components of the Program that we would like to share to your school. In this regard, we are seeking the support of your good office for the conduct of a **Two-Day Youth Entrepreneurship Training on January 13-14, 2018 at Bonbonon Elementary School in Siaton, Negros Oriental**. This training aims to improve the knowledge and skills of the youth on simple enterprise development. Through the activity, they will be able to assess themselves better, examine the conditions of their environment and explore possible opportunities, and be prepared in becoming the country's future entrepreneurs. The training is free, and meals, materials, and certificates will be provided.

For the activity, **we would like to invite two (2) Aflatoun students per school (11 to 15 years old)** who show potential to become young entrepreneurs and **one (1) Aflatoun teacher-in-charge per school to accompany the students and help observe in the workshops**. Our local co-op partner is also coordinating the activity with the schools and District Supervisors as part of the Aflatoun Financial Education Program. We hope that through our collective efforts, we can develop the capacity and potential of young people to create opportunities for themselves and live a life of creativity, success, and service through entrepreneurship. Looking forward to any favorable response you may grant this letter.
