Slogan Making Contest

Rules and Guidelines

1. The contest theme revolves around the importance of OK sa DepEd in achieving the learners' full educational potential.
2. Open to elementary pupils (Grades 4-6) only.
3. Only one (1) representative per district only.
4. Contestants shall wear their school uniforms during the contest.
5. The slogan must be original, in English or Filipino, and does not exceed 20 words.
6. All materials shall be provided by the contestant themselves.
7. Pupils are given 90 minutes to finish their work.
8. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

Format:

The slogan shall be written in any style using any materials in a ½ illustration board with any design of the contestant's choice.

Criteria for Judging:

Relevance to the theme	35%
Clarity and Coordination of words	30%
Originality	15%
Creativity and Design	10%
<u>Overall Visual Impact</u>	<u>10%</u>
Total	100%

Poster Making Competition

Rules and Guidelines

1. The contest theme is OK sa DepEd's role in achieving the learners' full educational potential.
2. Open to public secondary students (Grades 7-12) only.
3. Only one representative per district.
4. Contestants shall wear their school uniform during the contest.
5. Students are given only two (2) hours to finish their poster.
6. All materials shall be provided by the contestant themselves.
7. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.

Format:

The poster shall be made using any art materials of the contestant's choice in a ½ illustration board.

Criteria for Judging:

Relevance to the theme	40%
Creativity and Design	30%
Originality	15%
<u>Overall Visual Impact</u>	<u>15%</u>
