Greetings from the Philippine Folk Dance Society!

We would like to invite you and all MAPEH Teachers, Trainers, Students from the schools of Negros Oriental and the Island Province of Siquijor to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Provincial Folk Dance Workshop scheduled on August 3-5, 2018 at the Negros Oriental State University Cultural Complex, Negros Oriental State University, Main Campus, Dumaguete City.

The workshop will be conducted in partnership with the Philippine Folk Dance Society- National, the PFDS Negros Oriental Local Chapter and Negros Oriental State University.

Workshop activities include learning of published folk dances specifically from Sayaw: Dances of the Philippine Islands Volume 1, the review and learning of the fundamental dance steps and movements which are included in the new curriculum under the K-12 program for Physical Education and other related subjects plus the introduction of the newly accepted folk dance from Negros Oriental, the "KASAL DAUINANON" which is researched by the undersigned to be taught to all MAPEH teachers as part of thrust in embracing our local culture through dance. There are select topics on culture and the arts during the plenary sessions which will be discussed by invited speakers from the PFDS National Officers and from the Cultural Center of the Philippines. This dance workshop enhances the dance skills and capabilities of our teachers in the teaching of Philippine folk dances in the elementary and high school levels

Invited to attend are the MAPEH Teachers, School Dance Troupe Trainers and Choreographers, Students, Lifetime and Annual Local Chapter Members, Dance Enthusiasts, LGU Cultural and Tourism Officers, Cultural Events Coordinators and School and Community based Cultural Troupes/Groups.

A registration fee of **Two Thousand (P 2,000.00) for Professionals and One Thousand (P 1,000.00) for Students** shall be charged to cover the workshop expenses including workshop materials- dance handouts, CD, Workshop ID, Workshop T-shirt, Certificates, Honoraria for the Facilitators and Speakers and other incidental expenses. The registration fee, transportation, accommodation and meals may be charged from the school's MOOE.

Participants shall take care of their own transportation, accommodation and meals. Information about possible lodging and pension houses and hotels in Dumaguete City (for those participants who are not from Dumaguete City) may be facilitated by the local chapter officers and members.



# **WORKSHOP ADVISORY**

**ATTENDANCE.** Signing of attendance is a **MUST.** Attendance is used to record your time of amival and departure in the morning and afternoon sessions. Sessions starts at 7 am and ends at 8pm everyday for a total of 24 hours. Only those with at least 12 hours attendance, based on the record of attendance will receive Certificate of Participation.

**ATTIRE.** Appropriate and comfortable attire and footwear is needed during the workshop. Not allowed to be worm inside the venues are "sandos, leather shoes, and heeled shoes". Comfortable shoes are recommended.

**CLAIM STUBS.** Each participant will receive specific claim stubs for workshop materials and other purposes. Please write your name and ID number in all the claim stubs to facilitate distribution. Always bring these stubs with you and secure them tightly. Losing them will put you to disadvantage as you will be entertained last after everybody has been served.

PARTICIPANTS/LOCAL CHAPTER'S NIGHT. This is the fellowship activity for all the delegates. Participation is highly encouraged.

**DISTRIBUTION OF HANDOUTS AND CERTIFICATES.** Distribution of certificates and other workshop materials/handouts is on the last session in chronological order according to ID number and the color group you belong. Lining up or queuing when session/activity is still going on shall not be allowed.

ID CARD. We follow the policy of No ID, No Entry to NORSU Sports and Cultural Complex. Duly registered participants will be issued with identification cards with a picture taken by official photographer. Print your name legibly on your Id. IDs must always be worn while inside the venue for the duration of the workshop. ID will also serve as gate pass, ticket for the cultural shows and other purposes of the workshop only. Non-participants including children will not be allowed inside the workshop hall or theater.

**LUNCH AND SNACKS.** Meals at reasonable prices will be available for sale at specified food counters. However, you may opt to bring your own food provided that cleanliness and orderliness must be observed all the time.

PFDS LOCAL CHAPTER GENERAL ASSEMBLE. Only PFDS members are required to attend. Non-members may observe or rehearse the dances learned outside the venue.

PFDS MEMBERSHIP. Annual membership fee is Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php250.00). Lifetime membership fee is Five Hundred pesos (Php500.00).

**PERSONAL BELONGINGS.** Please do not leave your personal belongings and valuables unattended. The management will not be held responsible for any losses.

**STREET DANCING.** All participants will be grouped together according to colors to present different festivals based on the assigned Festivals from Negros Oriental. The parade of festivals will be held before the formal Opening Program. The Closing Program Street Dancing will be performed by each Color Group executing movements of the assigned dance in the workshop showcase.

**WORKSHOP SHOWCASE.** This culminating event is a dance showcase participated by all color groups. Each group shall present the assigned dance selected from the dances taught during the workshop. Presentations shall be on stage with at least 20 or more participants.
