Title: Seminar on Learner-centered Pedagogy

Participants: Secondary Private School Teachers within Negros Oriental Division

Date: February 14, 2019

Venue: San Pedro Academy Library

Rationale:

Teaching-learning process is an on-going process in the instructional procedures and activities.
