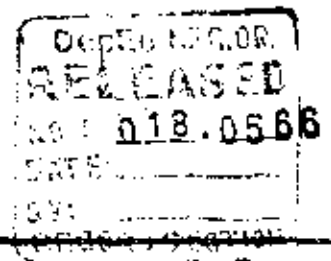

Dear Dr. Jimenez,

Adolescence (aged 10-19 years old) is a pivotal time in the life of a child. At this stage, adolescents are at times difficult to understand and to reach out to. They hardly seek care unless they are sick. If ever these adolescents come for care, there are many health concerns that need to be addressed. Therefore, utmost guidance and information from health service providers and workers is much needed.

However, to capacitate health service providers with enough knowledge and skills in dealing with adolescents, the Department of Health-Region 7 in coordination with the Provincial Health Office will conduct an **Orientatioa on Healthy Young Ones Fliptarp (HYO) and Adolescent Health Education and Praetieal Training (A.D.E.P.T.)**.

This training uses a Healthy Young Ones Tarpaulins with the following topics: puberty, reproductive system, menstruation, gender and health, reproduction and responsibility, sexually transmitted infections, and HIV and AIDS. The tarpaulin offers a wealth of Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health (ASRH) information to pave the way for desirable behavioral changes and development of critical life skills among adolescents towards the improvement of their health and well-being.

In this connection, we would like to invite 13 of your DepEd nurses to attend the above orientation on March 6-9, 2018 at Plaza Maria Luisa Suites Inn, Dumaguete City. Meals and accommodation will be charged to DOH-RO-7 funds, while traveling expenses, allowable per diems and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be shouldered by the sending agency. Each participant is advised to bring a laptop and a headset.

Furthermore, may we request that Negros Oriental High School be the venue during the practicum scheduled on March 2, 2018 for Batch-1 and March 9, 2018 for Batch-2, from 8:30am-10:00am. During the practicum, the training-participants will have the chance to apply their learnings by conducting information session to 48 selected students of your preference which will be divided into two equal groups.
