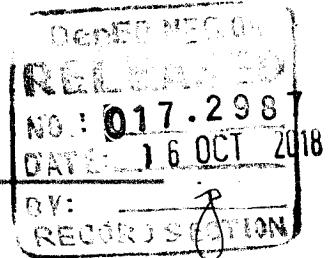

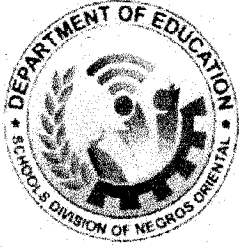

PSYCHOLOGICAL FIRST AID (PFA) TRAINING

This training is an effective strategy in responding to disasters and emergencies and to help learners and personnel who experienced traumatic event to release and validate their feelings and emotions and cope with their current situation.
2. The objectives of this training are as follows:
 - Empowered participants with skills and knowledge to provide Psychological First Aid (PFA) to affected DepEd personnel and learners;
 - Developed initial referral pathways for support;
 - Organized directory of PFA trainers;
 - Empowered participants with skills to recognize signs and symptoms of stress; and
 - Explores ways of reducing stress and providing peer support.
