- 1. This refers to the conduct of the subject activity on **December 3-5, 2018** to be held in **Ecotech Center, Sudion, Lahug, Cebu City**
- 2. In the pursuit of the foundational principles of DepEd Order 62, s. 2011 inclusion, participation and empowerment and in full recognition, respect and promotion of the rights of Indigenous Peoples to education, the Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Program of the Department of Education has ensured the participation and inclusion of the Indigenous Peoples communities and the inclusion of Indigenous Knowledge in the development of the IPEd Program. The current involvement of the Indigenous Peoples communities, particularly their indigenous knowledge systems, in contextualizing DepEd's curriculum and governance systems, mechanisms and processes of DepEd, demands a continuous dialogue with the Indigenous Cultural Communities (ICCs) through their representatives. The continuous dialogue will facilitate the process of contextualizing the national education system for IPEd.
- 3. The subject activity is envisioned to be an opportunity for the IP elders from the Island and Visayas regions to dialogue with DepEd educational managers on key concepts, processes, mechanisms and procedures vital to the current developments in IPEd. Community concerns and the institutionalization of the continuing dialogue of the ICCs with DepEd are also relevant agenda.

- 4. Participants to the activity are the key elders from the Indigenous Peoples Communities of Regions VI, VII, VIII and MIMAROPA. From DepEd, the participants are the following:
 - a. Regional Office: IPED Regional IPEd Focal Persons, Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) Chiefs and Education Support Services Division (ESSD) Chiefs
 - b. Division Offices: IPEd Division IPEd Focal Person, Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) Chiefs and Schools Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) Chiefs.
