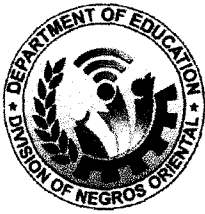


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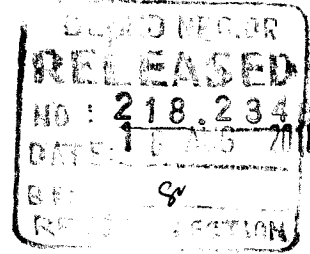

I. ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

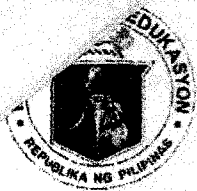
The Department of Education, in partnership with UNICEF Philippines and Child Protection Network Foundation, Inc., will be conducting a **National Child Protection Summit** with the theme "*Strengthening the implementation of the Child Protection Policy*" on **August 23-24, 2018** at **SMX Convention Center, Pasay City**.

The Summit aims to gather DepEd teaching and non-teaching personnel, as well as partners and stakeholders from various government and non-government agencies to discuss strategies that will strengthen the implementation of the Child Protection Policy (CPP) at the school level. This is anchored in the following sub-objectives:

- For the participants to gain insight on the issues in implementing the policy by examining existing studies and other efforts to monitor CPP;
- For the selected experts and child care practitioners to share their insights on the vulnerabilities that children encounter;
- For the partners to share promising practices on child protection;
- For the participants to identify gaps, challenges, and areas of priority action that will help strengthen the CPP; and
- For DepEd and stakeholders to identify strategic interventions and areas of collaboration.

In this regard, all Regional Offices (ROs) and all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are requested to send participants to this Summit. Participants are expected to have a background on child protection and have previously attended trainings, orientations, or seminars on the topic.
