

One-day Conference (October 22, 2018, 8AM – 5PM)

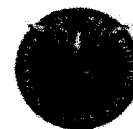

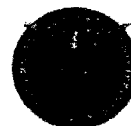

Concept Note

ACTRC Regional Conference

The Assessment Curriculum and Technology Research Centre (ACTRC) is a joint research centre between the Assessment Research Centre, University of Melbourne and the University of the Philippines (UP). The Centre was established in 2013 and is funded by the Australian Government. It was created to advise and inform the Philippine system of education through curriculum, teaching and assessment research based on empirical studies of curriculum innovation and implementation.

For the past five years, ACTRC has been conducting research that is focused on the K to 12 curriculum implementation and implications for student learning outcomes, pedagogy and educational policy. The Centre has established its reputation for producing evidence-based research through the development and use of assessment tools to inform the Department of Education (DepEd) about progress of student learning in the K to 12 curriculum. The Centre has also undertaken a longitudinal study of student achievement in the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, a nationwide study on multilingual education, and studies on formative assessment and the progression of students in science and mathematics curriculum.

ACTRC has conducted numerous dissemination and advocacy activities at the national and international levels. The Centre wishes to have a greater national reach by conducting a conference in DepEd region(s) that have been engaged in its research. This is also one way for the Centre to give back to the DepEd region(s) by sharing with them their research findings, so that regions are better informed of their implications.

The ACTRC Regional Conference will be a gathering of teachers, teacher educators, researchers and policy makers to share experiences and expertise in the areas of curriculum, instruction and assessment to inform and influence practice and policy in the context of the K to 12 curriculum. It will be a one-day conference, with an additional half day post-conference workshop to provide a more focused and in-depth approach on a selected topic. Participation in the conference will be free of charge but participants will be targeted and limited to 200 persons.

The conference aims to:

1. Provide space for stakeholders to learn about education research findings on curriculum, instruction and assessment
2. Convene educators, researchers, and development partners conducting empirical research on curriculum, instruction and assessment to have a holistic and integrated discussion
3. Disseminate ACTRC's research findings to improve the implementation of K to 12
4. Inform education policies and practices to address the immediate needs of students and teachers
