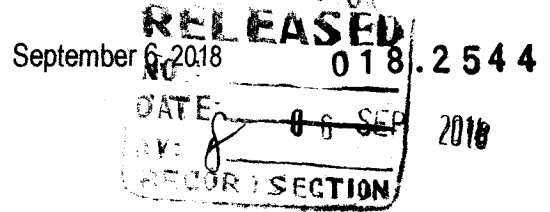

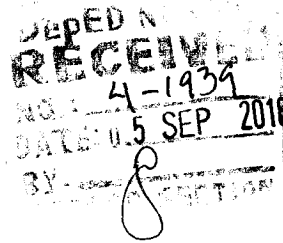

Gender Watch Against Violence and Exploitation, Inc. (GWAVE) has been working for over a decade now to address issues of women's rights and gender equality, in particular through the provision of free legal services for abused women and girls and the conduct of a wide range of advocacy activities. The Men for Violence-Free Communities (MVFC), one of GWAVE's programs, advocates for men to become partners in promoting Gender Equality & Non-Violence.

In 2016, GWAVE implemented a project creating a team of young male advocates who were members of the student government in the four schools namely: RPTM Dumaguete Science High School, Negros Oriental High School, Dumaguete City High School, and Junob National High School with the aim of engaging men to become actively involved in advocating for gender equality. As a result thereof, we have developed a group called Teen Advocates on Gender Awareness in Dumaguete aka "TAGAD". This year, GWAVE finds it necessary to expand to schools and train more teen advocates in order to increase the number of available male advocates.

We would like to share more of what the project is all about and our plans for the TAGAD in our upcoming phase. We would also like to solicit your views/ideas on how we could effectively partner with your school in furthering the advocacy of raising gender-fair men in our public high schools.
