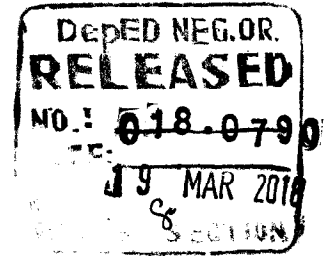

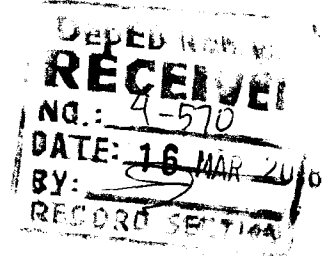


In this light, we would like to **request your good office to allow your information officer to attend the briefing.** The activity comes with a registration fee of P300.
