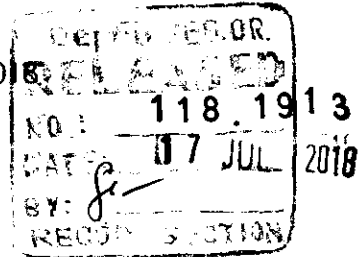

VIII – Rationale

The Department of Education is a government agency responsible for the holistic development of young Filipinos through an authentic and enhanced K to 12 basic curriculum.
