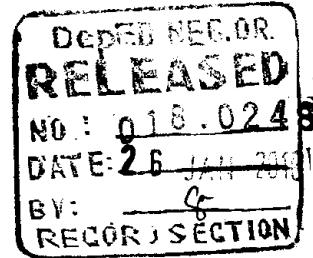

1. Regional Memorandum No. 1024, s. 2018 dated January 5, 2018 announces the conduct of the K to 12 Tech-Voc National Summit 2018 by the DepEd in collaboration with the Philippines Association of Vocational Education Administrators (PAVEA), Inc. with the theme "Repositioning Tech-Voc Education for Lifelong Learning of the K to 12 Graduates for Global Competitiveness from February 13-15, 2018 at the International Eucharistic Congress Convention Center, Pope John II Avenue, Cebu City.
