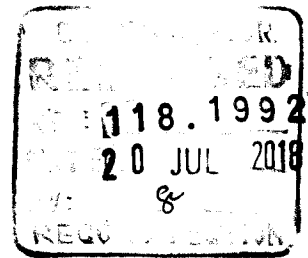

Criteria for Judging

CRITERIA	Behaviour and Practice	Talent	Intelligence and Wit	Community and School Participation	Presence and Appearance
100%	20% This can be measured through interviews and testimonials from their families, neighbors, friends, teachers, classmates, etc.	20% This can be measured through the talent portion. Talents include (but not limited to) singing, dancing, drawing, oration, extemporaneous speaking, and others.	20% This can be measured by looking at the scholastic records of the child, testimonials of his/her teachers, as well the way he/she responds to interviews.	20% This can be measured by looking at the child's participation and involvement in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.	20% This can be measured by how the child presents himself/herself on interviews as well as how they communicate the program and the thrusts of the program.

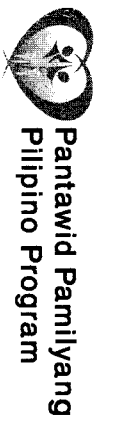
