## Dear Dr. Bongalos,

Based on the Republic Act 10354, known as the Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health (RPRH) Act of 2012, the adolescents (aging 10-19 years old) and youth have the right to reproductive health information and services. Thus, in line with our continuing activity for the implementation of the Adolescent Health & Youth Development Program (AHYDP) in the province, once again, the Provincial Health Office (PHO) thru its Population Outreach Program will conduct **Training-Orientations on Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) and Healthy Young Ones (HYO)** to various high schools.

The objective of the training is to provide critical health information to adolescents especially on Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health (ASRH). It also aims to pave the way for desirable behavioral changes and development of critical life skills among adolescents towards the improvement of their health and well-being.

This training uses a Healthy Young Ones IEC materials with the following topics: puberty, reproductive system, menstruation, gender and health, reproduction and responsibility, sexually transmitted infections, and HIV and AIDS.

Knowing that majority of these adolescents are in school, we would like to request once again, that we, together with the Municipal RHU focal person on AHDP be allowed to conduct the above-mentioned activity preferably to Grade 7 students who will be divided into two equal groups: Group 1 is 8:30am-10:30am and group 2 is 1:00pm-3:00pm on the following dates, school/venue and number of students:
