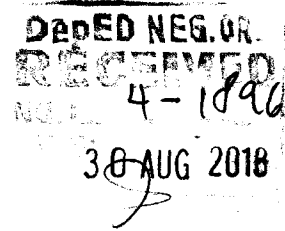

MECHANICS for the 6th VMC Interschool Art Competition:

1. ON-THE-SPOT CONTEST CATEGORIES

- a. Interschool Elementary (school-based Elementary from Negros Oriental and Occidental - Grades 1 to 6)
- b. Interschool Secondary (school-based in Secondary from Negros Oriental and Occidental - Grades 7 to 12)

2. Interested participants may register on-line at victoriasmilling.com. Registrants are required to upload a snapshot of a previous work to complete their registration. Deadline of registration is on September 9, 2018.

3. All participants must be endorsed by their respective School's representative.

4. Only the participants and authorized members of VMC are allowed in the competition area while the contest is on-going. No gadgets are allowed inside the competition area.

5. Medium to be used: Acrylic colors on canvas

6. Criteria:

- a. Originality
- b. Relevance to the Theme
- c. Handling of Medium
- d. Over-all impact

7. Judging:

- a. Registration entries: A maximum of 20 participants per category per province will be selected for the On-the-Spot contest based on the registration form and sample artwork submitted.
- b. On-the-Spot contest: The semi-finalists will be selected after the Dumaguete and Bacolod on-the-spot contests.
 - i. Interschool Elementary: 10 semi finalists from Negros Oriental and Occidental
 - ii. Interschool Secondary: 10 semi finalists from Negros Oriental and Occidental
- c. Final Judging:
 - i. Final Winners:
 1. Interschool Elementary: Champion, 1st and 2nd runners up
 2. Interschool Secondary: Champion, 1st and 2nd runners up
